I am directed to inform you that the Administrator is pleased to grant your school provisional recognition for one year with effect from 1st January, 1956 with permission to present candidates at the School Final Examination in 1957, subject to the "General Conditions" (Annexe - A) dealing with matters of common concern to all such schools as also to the conditions applicable in particular to your school (Annexe B). A report that the conditions marked with an asterisk have been fulfilled and that steps have been taken to fulfil the other conditions, should be forwarded to the Board by 31st March 1956. The report should be drawn up in two parallel columns - the conditions being shown in the ~~first~~ left column and the action taken by the school should be stated in the right column against each condition. Copies of the report should be forwarded simultaneously to the Director of Public Instruction and the District Inspecting Officer concerned under intimation to this office.

The question of granting your school further extension of recognition will be considered on receipt of the report.

The conditions attached to the recognition are to be strictly complied with. In default, the Board reserves the power to cancel or withdraw recognition.
